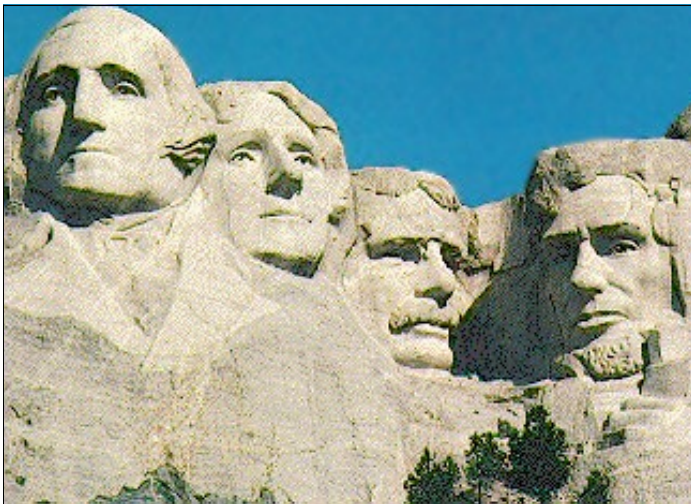

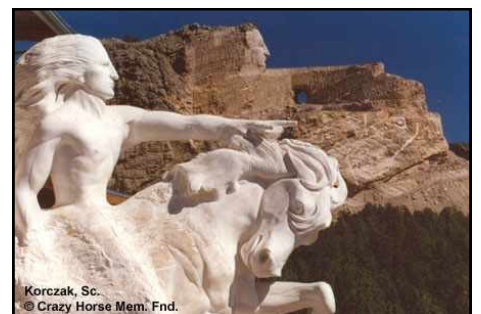

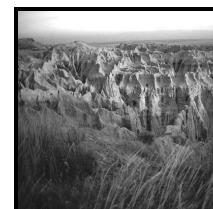

Ever since park rangers started rounding up some 1,500 head of buffalo each fall for the annual branding, sorting and vaccinating, visitors have been fascinated by this Old West tradition. Thrill to the wonder of these pre-historic beasts rumbling by a designated - and safe - viewing area to the corrals. Begins and ends in Rapid City, SD.

SEPT 22 <> FLIGHT TO RAPID CITY & CUSTER STATE PARK <> Transfer to a local airport for your flight to Rapid City Regional Airport. Transfer to Comfort Inn & Suites or Palmer Gulch Lodge for the next five nights. The new rock and log construction lends the lodge just the right rustic charm for our Black Hills adventure. **(Dinner)**

SEPT 23 <> MOUNT RUSHMORE & CRAZY HORSE MEMORIAL <> This morning's brief drive will bring us to Crazy Horse Memorial,



the still unfinished mountain carving dedicated to Native Americans, and the rejuvenated arts community of Hill City with

its funky shops, galleries, boutiques. We'll "dine with the Presidents" at Mount Rushmore, the Shrine to Democracy, before attending the Buffalo Roundup Arts Festival. This one-of-a-kind event includes a buffalo wallow chili cook-off, buffalo chip throwing contest, cowboy poets, musical entertainment, arts & crafts booths and much more. After a wonderful day of exploring and sightseeing we'll return to the lodge for another restful night in the mountain air.

SEPT 24 <> CUSTER STATE PARK BUFFALO ROUNDUP & IRON MOUNTAIN ROAD <> We'll be up bright and early this morning to take in the exciting annual buffalo roundup. Feel the thunder as 1,500 head of buffalo rumble by and park personnel, cowboys and cowgirls do



their best to drive the Park's herd into the Buffalo Corrals - passing two designated viewing

areas along the way. After the herd is safely in the corrals the park staff will sort, brand, test and select certain animals for the fall sale, held later in November. This afternoon we'll drink in the beauty of these forested mountains on the scenic byway, Iron Mountain Road with its pigtail bridges, mountain switchbacks, and amazing tunnels which perfectly frame the faces of Mount Rushmore. A train ride on the historic 1880 Steam Train rounds out this very special day. **(Continental Breakfast)**



SEPT 25 <> HISTORIC DEADWOOD

Today we'll explore the rich and roistering gold camp of Deadwood, which provided the setting for the last great gold rush in America. Legalized gaming has returned to the storied gulch where the likes of Wild Bill Hickock, Calamity Jane and Poker Alice once walked. We'll have time to try our luck at the tables, as well as tour historic Boot Hill where the legends now rest. **(Continental Breakfast & Dinner)**
